## \$1.85 million to parties

Nineteen parties and coalitions will receive MT 50 million (\$1.85 mn) for the election. Frelimo gains the largest amount (MT 22 mn, \$810,000) while the tiny PRDS which is standing only in Niassa receives the least (MT 107,000, \$4000).

The MT 50 million has been divided into four equal parts by the National Election Commission.

One quarter (MT 12.5 mn, \$462,000) is divided equally among the three presidential candidates.

The next quarter goes to the two parties in parliament, divided according to the number of seats. But Renamo was in the previous parliament in a coalition with several small parties, so the share of MT 4.5 mn goes to the Renamo Electoral Union, and it is not clear if any of that will go to the small parties in the coalition.

The third quarter goes to all parties standing for national assembly, in proportion to the number of seats they are contesting. The fourth quarter goes to parties standing for provincial assembly, also in proportion to the number of seats being contested.

Full details are given in the table on the next page.

Half the money will be distributed immediately, and the rest distributed in two tranches once the previous money has been accounted for. Money can be used for posters and other campaign expenses, but not for salaries, buildings, or purchase or rehabilitation of vehicles.
